LET PRAISE BE AN ATTITUDE

Breaking of Bread: Psalms 29:1-11

- 1. Praise is talking to God solely because is God. "Exodus 6:2 And God spake unto Moses, and said unto him, I am the LORD"
- 2. Praise is telling Him about His special attributes, His power, His might, His Strength, His, honour, His glory etc. **1Chronicles 16:34 O give thanks unto the LORD; for** *he is* good; for his mercy *endureth* for ever.
- 3. Praise is talking to God about the mighty things, humanly and otherwise impossible things that He did to fathers and saints of old. Psa 105:2 Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him: talk ye of all his wondrous works.

- 4. Praise is telling God about mighty things, extraordinary things, supernatural things He has done, or He is doing (or He can do or will do) in your life, family and the in the lives of other people you can see. Psa 105:5 Remember his marvellous works that he hath done; his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth;
- 5. Praise is talking to God about His mercies to those who have gone before us and to us (and to others around us).
- 6. Praise is believing God for a miracle even when He has not done it. Simply put, praise is faith. Heb 11:1-2 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. (2) For by it the elders obtained a good report.
- 7. Praise is not a substitute for prayer. Praise is prayer. Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.
- 8. Praise is giving back to God (fruits of your lips, dancing, willing offerings and sacrifices in finance, physical resources and personal endowments etc instead of asking as it is written in Acts 20:35 "I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive."

Him in ways otherwise won't be possible. When we praise Him, we align ourselves to Him. When we praise Him we are move to enter a realm where we can touch Him, feel Him, enjoy Him and receive mercy from Him.

- 10. Praise increase our faith in His ability to safe and deliver.
- 11. Praise secure peace for a grateful heart, as it is written "And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful" (Col. 3:15).
- 12. Praise take you from the physical to the spiritual. That it might be said of us "Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need" (Heb. 4:16).
- 13. Praise will not just bring the Spirit of God to your room, it takes you to the Throne room of God, praise releases you into the Hands of the blessed Holy Spirit, the Comforter, Who knows the mind of the Father, Who on your behalf will utter words too deep for the heart of man, in manner and language heaven cannot refused. Praise releases your lips, your body, your mind and your heart to God in the place of prayer as it is written Romans 8:26 "Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with

groanings which cannot be uttered."

- 14. Enter into the realm of prayer with praise, praise will not discard prayer, it help to sustain the one that pray before an holy God before Whom we are unworthy were it not for His mercy.
- 15. Never go to the altar of sacrifice of prayers without the fitting garment of praise. Matthew 22:11-12 "And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: (12) And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless."
- 16. Waiting on God become easier when we learn to trust Him. We have too much to thank Him for if we but look away from self-pity and worry, which have never benefit those who are given to it.
- 17. Getting worried about things you cannot help is of no use, no one ever swim through the ocean of worry and come out from the other end better than it started. Col 4:2 Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;
- 18. No one wait on God and died worrying, for they have learn to place their burden on Him. Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him was their common song (Job 13:15).

- 19. Praise keep you in the secret place of the Most High (Psalms 91:1).
- 20. Praise will secure the coming harvest. If you sow surely you will reap same, and in multiple folds. **Gal 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.** If you sow the seed of praise/prayers, you will surely reap the same.
- 21. Praise should be voluntary and wiling offering. **2Co 9:7** Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- 22. Add any other personal/family requests.
- 23. Cover all prayers/praise and answers with the Blood of Jesus Christ and seal all with Amen.
