## RENEWAL OF VOWS AND COMMITMENTS

**Breaking of Bread: Leviticus 26:1-13** 

Psalms 16:4 Their sorrows shall be multiplied that hasten after another god: their drink offerings of blood will I not offer, nor take up their names into my lips.

Every family is run by one covenant or another, just as every human being is subject to one higher power or another in worship, directly or not, every family serves one god or another. Some of these covenants and worships are passed down from generation to generation but for us and our families, we run our lives, raise our children, and live our lives by the promises of the Bible, often referred to as the Covenant of Words according to Isaiah 59:21.

God promise to put His Spirit upon us and His Word in our hearts and in the hearts of our children and that if we ask anything according to His Word in prayer, He will do them for us (please ask one of the children to read, Isaiah

59:21; and another to read 1John 5:14-15 and explain each to them. Parents should allow children to ask questions at any point in the study).

For us and our families, we will serve the Lord our God, our vows, our services and commitments are to Him alone and no other god with Him. In seasons like this, it is an opportunity to renew our family's commitments and vows to Him, just like Joshua and His family did in Joshua 24:15 (please let one of the children read the passage). God has promised to be our God, it is only wise if we too dedicate our vows, our services and our commitments to Him alone to reciprocate His love toward us.

## **Theme Songs:**

- 1. I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations (Psalms 89:1).
- 2. The stedfast love of our God never ceased, His mercies never run to an end. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness (Lamentations 3:23).

## RENEWAL OF VOWS AND COMMITMENTS

Vows are solemn commitment and promise to serve, worship and honour only One God. God hates rivalry because He's a jealous God. We must know no other name apart from the Name of Jesus Christ, we have no other protection apart from the protection in the Blood of Jesus Christ, we must have no other power apart from the Power of the Holy Spirit and we must use no other word in prayer apart from the Word of God in the Bible. These are our vows and our commitments to God, the Father of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen!

Deuteronomy 6:4-5 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Leviticus 26:1 Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the LORD your God.

- a. Father, I and my family are committed to You alone in Jesus Name. Amen
- b. Our vows and services, and all our resources are from You and are for You alone in Jesus Name.
- c. Father, on behalf of myself, my children and my entire family, we renew our commitment to the Name of Jesus Christ, and we say we are committed to the Blood of Jesus Christ in Jesus Mighty Name. Amen
- d. Father, we renew our commitment to the Covenant of Words and all Bible promises for the everlasting benefits of my family and the lives of my children in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen

Deuteronomy 6:7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

e. My family will never go back to idol worships under no circumstance, I will not enter into any evil covenant on behalf of my children, knowingly or not, my children will never serve devils in Jesus Name. Amen.

Leviticus 26:4 Then I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her increase, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit.

f. Father, as we have confessed You, our lands (business and sources of livelihood) shall yield their increase and our fields shall yield her fruits in Jesus Name. Amen

Leviticus 26:5 And your threshing shall reach unto the vintage, and the vintage shall reach unto the sowing time: and ye shall eat your bread to the full, and dwell in your land safely.

g. Father, as we have confessed You afresh, our children will grow up to their full potential in you, our pregnancies shall reach their full terms, and all shall end in safe births in Jesus Name. Amen

h. As we have confessed You, Father, we shall eat our bread to the full, You shall bless our waters, and we shall be safe from evil and dwell in our land (family) safely in Jesus Name. Amen

i. Father, as we have confessed You afresh, for our sake, our land (country, town, cities and neighborhood) shall dwell in peace and safety in Jesus Name. Amen

Leviticus 26:6 And I will give peace in the land, and ye shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid: and I will rid evil beasts out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land.

j. Father, as we have confessed You, nothing shall make us and our children afraid, all evil beasts (terrorists, foreign invasion, kidnappers, ritualists etc) shall have no place in our lives and we shall be free from violence in Jesus Name. Amen

Leviticus 26:7 And ye shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword.

k. Father, as we have confessed and renew our vows with You, we shall never bow before our enemies but our enemies shall fall before us in Jesus Name. Amen 1. I declare henceforth, my children are Yours, our young men and women are yours, no evil is permitted to touch any of them in Jesus Name. Amen

Leviticus 26:11-12 And I will set my tabernacle among you: and my soul shall not abhor you. And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be my people.

m. Father, as we have renew our vows and commitments to You, please make our families Your dwelling place. Walk in my family, be our God and we shall be Your people forever in Jesus Precious Name. Amen

- n. Add your personal/family prayer requests.
- o. Cover all prayers and Praise with the Blood of Jesus Christ and seal all prayer and praise with Amen.

May God bless you and keep you rejoicing in His love and promises. May the Covenant of Words and the promises thereof find expression in you and in all yours to the praise and glory of our God and our Father in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen
