LIFE AFTER THE COVENANT HAS BEEN MADE

Breaking of Bread: Genesis 17:1-10

Covenant is a deal or an agreement between two or more parties (persons, group, families, nations etc.) to promote a common position together in the favour of those involved with the deed of the covenant so agreed on. After the deed of the covenant has been reached and signed by those directly concerned, then there are expectations, from both parties and their families, things that must be done, life that must be lived afterward and the pattern of behaviours consistent with the new arrangement must be set forth for those involved with the agreement in order for such covenants to stay binding and working as expected. God told Abram after He covenanted with Him: **''walk before Me''** (Genesis 17:1).

LIFE AFTER THE COVENANT HAS BEEN MADE

God told Abram after He covenanted with Him: "walk before me and be thou perfect" (make that walk consistent with the agreement reached between me and you and your generations forever - Genesis 17:1). What are God's expectations of us today who are carrier of His Life and Grace through Covenant sealed in the Blood of Jesus Christ?

1. Looking unto Jesus: As a covenant carrier you must always remember you are not the one who made covenant with God, but it is God Who made covenant with you, through Jesus Christ, therefore, you must always look up unto Him for everything in respect of the Covenant of Words and all the benefits in it.

Luke 9:62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

a. Father, help me to stay focused on You. I must not lose sight of You in Jesus Name. Amen

b. I am marching forward, I will not look back in Jesus Name.

c. I will look up to Jesus Christ, the Author and Finisher of my faith in Jesus Name.

Psalms 123:1-2 Unto thee lift I up mine eyes, O thou that dwellest in the heavens. Behold, as the eyes of servants look unto the hand of their masters, and as the eyes of a maiden unto the hand of her mistress; so our eyes wait upon the LORD our God, until that he have mercy upon us.

Genesis 17:1 And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

d. I refuse to be derail and move away from God, unto You will I lift up my eyes for help and mercies in Jesus Name.

e. As the eyes of servants look unto the hand of their masters, and as the eyes of a maiden unto the hand of her mistress; so my eyes wait upon the LORD my God, to keep me going in the path of His covenant with me in JESUS CHRIST Mighty Name.

2. Expect the Miracles and the Answers: Always expect things to change, nobody walk with God and still remain the same. God will answer all petitions, look forward to having the miracle, be expectant and believe God will send the answers and do for you and all yours as He has promised He will at the point of covenant.

Romans 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

Psalms 20:4-5 Grant thee according to thine own heart, and fulfil all thy counsel. We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the LORD fulfil all thy petitions.

a. I will wait on God, I know He will grant me my heart desire and fulfil all my petitions to Him in Jesus Name. Amen

b. I'm expectant, I will trust in God for the fulfilment of His promises for me and for my family in Jesus Name. Amen

Hebrews 4:11 Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

1 John 5:14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:

c. Father, I will hold on to Your word, help my unbelief, I will not miss out of Your promises through unbelief in Jesus Name. Amen

d. I know God heard me, I know my petitions are before Him and I have confidence in His ability to answer prayers and turn situation around for best for those whose trusts are in Him in Jesus Name.

3. Walk in Faith and Live By Faith: It takes faith to walk with God. Without faith no man can please Him. God don't start working from the physical and the tangible to the spiritual but rather He always began from the spiritual to the tangible. You can't get anything from God unless you have faith it has been giving to you first in the spirit and have faith you will see the physical manifestations too.

Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Romans 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

a. I will walk by faith, I will live by faith, and I will not waiver in faith until I see God move on my behalf and in the behalf of my children in Jesus Name.

b. I have peace with God, I'm not worried and I'm not disturbed, I will hold on to the Name and the Blood of Jesus Christ in the days of my waiting in Jesus Name. Amen

1 Corinthians 16:13 Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

c. I will stand in faith, I will be strong and believing in God ability to do as He has promised in Jesus Name. Amen

d. What I see, hear or how I feel will no longer determine the level of my faith, for we walk by faith and not by sight in Jesus Name. Amen

4. You Are Now Different: You are now a covenant carrier, your lifestyle, your words, utterances and conducts must reflect the God of that covenant. There must be very visible changes in you that reflect your new status, you can't meet with God and still be the old you. Everyone around you (spouse, children, friends and neighbours) must observe and testify to the new you. A covenant carrier must stand out among the crowd.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Genesis 17:5 Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.

a. I will live and dress and talk in manner consistent with the Covenant of Words in Jesus Name. My lifestyle and conducts will not be opposite the grace of JESUS CHRIST in Jesus Name. Amen

b. My lifestyle and my private and public conducts will not betray the covenant and the God of my covenant in JESUS CHRIST Name.

c. I chose to be different, I will no longer operate or dress or talk like the world around me that have no understanding of the God I serve and the covenant I carry in Jesus Name. Amen

d. Abram became Abraham after You gave Him the covenant, Father, let there be visible changes in my life, and in my conducts and in my family that are corresponding to the new status in Jesus Christ in Jesus Name. Amen

Exodus 34:29 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.

Acts 4:13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

e. Men and women will see You in me, even my children and family members will see You through me and will know that I have been with Jesus in Jesus Name. Amen

5. Don't offend Him: Beware of God, He's in you and always with you, don't do things that will offend Him. He's a covenant keeping God, and also a consuming fire. God hates sin and whoever loves what God hates is an enemy of God. A covenant carrier have only one interest, to please God Who has graciously given Him life and hope in Himself.

Jude 1:21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Deuteronomy 23:14 For the LORD thy God walketh in the midst of thy camp, to deliver thee, and to give up thine enemies before thee; therefore shall thy camp be holy: that he see no unclean thing in thee, and turn away from thee.

a. Father, expose and show me every forms of uncleanness in me and around me, and help me to get rid of them, don't turn away from me and turn against me and against my children in Jesus Name. b. Father, help me to keep myself and my family in Your love and mercy to the very end in Jesus Name.

Proverbs 16:7 When a man's ways please the LORD, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him.

2 Timothy 2:4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

c. I'm a soldier for Christ, I refuse to get busy with the affairs of this life and displease my Lord and the God of my covenant in Jesus Name. Amen

d. I will live my life to please God, for He will make my enemies in and around me, whatever name they are called, to be at peace with me in Jesus Name. Amen

e. Present your personal/family prayer requests list and your vow to God again.

f. Cover all prayers with the Blood of Jesus Christ and seal all prayer and praise with Amen.
