COVENANT OF MERCY: SURE MERCIES OF DAVID

Breaking of Bread: Isaiah 55:1-13

The sure mercies of David is God irrevocable covenant of mercy (love, kindness, favour, goodness and grace) to David and his children forever. It is an everlasting covenant. In it God vow to extend his mercy to David to His children forever when He said "My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. His seed also will I make to endure for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven" (Psalms 89:28-29). How do this extend to us?

Jesus Christ is the Root of David, and by Him, and through His influence, His death and resurrection God gave to us the "sure mercies of David" that by Him and in Him we and our children might be accorded the same privileges and benefits of love and grace in the everlasting covenant of mercy. This was reveal to us, by the Holy Ghost through Apostle Paul when he said Acts 13:32 And we declare unto you glad tidings, how that the promise which was made unto the fathers, God hath fulfilled the same unto us their

children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again... And as concerning that he raised him up from the dead...he said on this wise, I will give you the sure mercies of David'' (Acts 13:32-34).

Because Jesus Christ was risen from the dead, God said **"I will give you the sure mercies of David".** We believe the promise and we rejoice in the knowledge of it. We are nothing and we can do nothing without the mercy of God in Christ Jesus.

Acts 13:32-34 And we declare unto you glad tidings, how that the promise which was made unto the fathers, God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again...And as concerning that he raised him up from the dead...he said on this wise, I will give you the sure mercies of David.

a. Father, have mercy upon me and upon my children and their children's children in Jesus Name.

b. Father, please show mercy to my lineage in Jesus Name.

2 Samuel 23:5 Although my house be not so with God; yet he hath made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things, and sure: for this is all my salvation, and all my desire...

Psalms 89:28-29 My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. His seed also will I make to endure for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven.

c. Father, let your covenant with me and with my household, be an everlasting covenant, **ordered in all things**, and sure in Jesus Name.

d. Father let your mercy on me and on my children be irrevocable, stedfast and sure in Jesus Name. Amen

Psalms 18:50 Great deliverance giveth he to his king; and sheweth mercy to his anointed, to David, and to his seed for evermore.

e. Father, by Your mercy, deliver me from all my fears, safe me and all mine from all evil for Your Name sake in Jesus Name. Amen

f. Father, I and my children belong to You, deliver me from all generational and inherited troubles, deliver me from all familiar wicked spirit in Jesus Name.

Psalms 89:30-33 If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments; If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments; Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail.

No matter how we train our children, there will be time children will be children, we all make mistakes but we can pray our children away from terrible irrevocable mistakes that can set them on a collision course with God and rob them of His mercy.

g. Father, please keep my children far from irrevocable mistakes in Jesus Name.

h. Father, don't let any of my children dine with the devil or fellowship with the wicked before they dine with You in Jesus Name. Amen i. Father, please always remember Your mercy when dealing with my children in Jesus Name.

j. Father, please don't take your loving kindness away from my family and don't allow any of my children walk away from Your love in Jesus Name. Amen

Psalms 89:34-37 My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David. His seed shall endure for ever, and his throne as the sun before me. It shall be established for ever as the moon, and as a faithful witness in heaven. Selah.

k. Father, let these promises be true for me and for my children and for their children's children in all my lineage in Jesus Name.

1. I confess the sure mercies of David is my by covenant right, and same for my household and for my children in all their generations in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen

m. Add your personal/family prayer requests.

n. Cover all prayers and your family health with the Blood of Jesus Christ and seal all prayer and praise with Amen.

May God bless you and keep you rejoicing in His love and promises. May the Covenant of Words and the promises thereof find expression in you and in all yours to the praise and glory of our God and our Father in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen
