It is His will that we operate henceforth as one united organized Army of the Kingdom, expanding His Kingdom beginning from the hearts of our families to the uttermost part of the earth, till the whole earth is covered with His glory and with the Vision and the Mission of the army of Praying Parents that we are.

We won't rest until Christ is formed in the heart of every child, Partner in every marriage and The Commander in Chief in every family. We are an important part of God's Army, and to do our parts in pleasing the Lord of Hosts, our Commander in Chief, Jesus Christ the Righteous, then we must take note of the following:

1. Never stop adding and improving on your qualifications being a part of the host.

The sole aim of every soldier is to please the Person that enlisted him. He will keep improving on himself, adding values and enviable qualities to Himself.

- 1 Timothy 1:18 This charge I commit unto thee, son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou by them mightest war a good warfare;
- 2 Timothy 2:4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.
- a. I will fight as a good soldier, I will fight a good warfare and I will keep my position in Jesus Name. Amen
- 2 Peter 1:5-7 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to

temperance patience; and to patience godliness; And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.

- b. I will keep adding value to my qualifications, I won't be stagnant and unproductive in God's Army in Jesus Name. Amen
- c. I value my place and position among the rank and file of God's army, I will not be replaced and I will not lose my position in Jesus Name. Amen

Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

- d. My thoughts, my works and the report about me, especially from my own family will commensurate with the training I have received in Jesus Name. Amen
- 2. Every member recognize and committed to the same vision and mission.

MISSION: THAT NO CHILD SHOULD EVER WALK ALONE WITHOUT THE SPIRITUAL SUPPORT OF PRAYING PARENTS THEREBY HELPING MORE CHILDREN FULFIL THEIR GOD ORDAINED DESTINIES – 2SAM. 11:14-17

None of the above statements will find fulfillment in us and through us if we are not committed (deliberately and intentionally) to our marriages and families.

a. I declare I am totally committed to my marriage/family, as a way to promote and uphold the vision and mission of this Community of Praying Parents in Jesus Name. Amen

b. I will prayer cover for my children and for my family and all other family and children in 3pG in Jesus Name. Amen

c. I will prayerfully guide my children to the plan of God for each one of them, till the will of God is fully expressed in my family in Jesus Name. Amen

3. Love the "Nation" you represent intensely

Love birth commitment and faithfulness. Your commitment to spiritual warfare on the behalf of your children and family is proportional to your love for the Lord and for them. That's why you must be weary of personal and domestic distractions. Also avoid turning your weapons against the same people you are called to defend.

1 Peter 2:17 Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

1Pe 2:21 For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

a. I love my family, I refuse to be distracted in Jesus Name. Amen

b. I will not lose my faith, I won't trade my salvation for anything. I am a winner for Jesus Christ in Jesus Name. Amen

c. I will not turn my weapon of war against my own family. I will defend my spouse, my children and entire household in the place of prayer in Jesus Name. Amen

4. Have workable plans and ideas and work towards it.

If we are indeed members and part of the Army of the Lord, we must plan and develop workable plans and ideas on how to help fulfil the vision and mission of the Group in your own little corner. Work out visible ideas on how to form Jesus Christ in your children, in your marriage and family as well. For example, I will reach out to the children during evening dinner (daily, every other day or once a week etc). I will be gentle, understanding and patience with my spouse and with my habits I will preach Jesus Christ to him/her etc.

2 Timothy 2:4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

1Peter 4:7-9 But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. Use hospitality one to another without grudging.

- a. I will be patient with my family, I will see to it that Christ is formed in my children in Jesus Name. Amen
- b. I will not submit to failure, if I failed, I will try again and again in Jesus Name.
- c. I will consciously work on my actions and inactions, I will be a true representative of Jesus Christ in my family in Jesus Name. Amen
- 5. A good soldier will listen, follow and obey new directives without compromising the old.

A good soldier is open to instructions. He will follow through with an order and obey the Commander's Voice without compromising his stance. If you are part of us, you must eat from the same table with us.

John 10:4 And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice.

John 10:5 And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.

A tired and weak soldiers cannot effectively carry out the task of soldering. We all need a good body and a balance emotions to do God's will.

1Peter 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Psalms 29:10-11 The LORD sitteth upon the flood; yea, the LORD sitteth King for ever. The LORD will give strength unto his people; the LORD will bless his people with peace.

a. I will not be tired, the will give me strength and the Lord will bless me with peace in Jesus Name.

b. By His stripes, I am healed in Jesus Name. Amen

c. The Lord will reign as King upon the storm and the flood in my life and family in Jesus Name

7. Add your personal and family prayer requests.

8. Cover all prayers and lessons learned with the Blood of Jesus Christ and seal them with Amen.
