BUILDING BLOCK 4: PATIENCE

Breaking of Bread: 2 Peter 1:1-6, 8, 10-11

An online dictionary define **patience as the capacity to accept or tolerate delay, problems, or suffering without becoming annoyed or anxious.**

Patience is not a virtue you employ when things are right, a perfect situation required no patience. A perfect spouse will need no patience to leave with. An obedient child or an easy going subordinate will need no patience to deal with. Patience can only be deploy when things are going contrary to one's expectations. Daniel 3:17-18 If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Romans 16:25 Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began, Ephesians 3:3 How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

13. Impatience will not rob me of divine revelations about me and about my children and about family in Jesus Name. Amen

14. (i) I repent from past habits of impatience. I will no longer be blind and void of understanding of spiritual things in respect of my life and the lives of my loved ones in Jesus Name. Amen

(ii) Henceforth, I will be deliberate, determined, diligent and intentional about adding patience to my life in Jesus Name. Amen

16. Cover all prayers with the Blood of Jesus Christ and seal them with Amen.

May you not be counted among them who draw back unto perdition, may your feet not fall off the grace of Jesus Christ and May you by Him find strength and grace for spiritual stability, now and always in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen and Amen
