OUR FATHER: HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME

Breaking of Bread: Luke 11:1-2

Our Call, our spiritual birth and our adoption into the Family of God is in all way similar to the call and election of Abraham. Just like Abraham, He called us from darkness into His light, from our idolatrous background into a new life with Him. We were unworthy but He called, justified and qualified us as sons and daughters of God. Abraham belief God, obeyed Him and walked with Him. And of us in like manner it is said, "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name" (John 1:12).

It was Jesus that brought us into God and by Him we were adopted into the Family of God and it was Him Who revealed God to us as our Father. The life of any kingdom is expressed in words (language) and conversation (manner of talking) of its citizens. And in teaching us the lifestyle and ways of the Kingdom, just as God taught Abraham the manner of His walk with Him, the first thing Jesus taught us was the recognition of our new Parenthood in God and the Worship of the same, He said, when ye pray (converse with God), start by saying: "Our Father Who art in heaven Hallowed be thy Name." This, like a two sided coin, is the first and the most important attitude every

Kingdom person must have. First, recognize and accept Him as your Father, and secondly, hallowed His Name.

1. OUR FATHER: MY FATHER AND MY GOD

If we only see God as Judge and fail to see Him more intimately as our Father, it will hampered our relationship with Him a lot. The judge who sat in a courtroom and passed sentence on an accused will hanged his gown in a courtroom and go back home after the day's work as a father to his children, and expectedly none of the children will relate with him as a judge, that's what he is to those outside the house but for members of his family, especially his children, he is only their father, their guide and the head of their family. A father may discipline a son but He never judges his son. Christ was judged for us, that we might become sons and daughters of God.

God is our Father, we must accept Him as such, that's Who He is to Jesus Christ, and the uncompromising Judge of those outside His Family. If we put on this attitude, the mind of God for us is half fulfilled already. We often missed out of God's blessings and plans for us, many times, because our perception of Him is rarely different from the way the accused sees the judge instead as a son or daughter patiently waits to fall into the loving hands of a father after a long day at work. If you see God as your Father, you will enjoy Him as a Father but if you keep Him before your eyes as your Judge only, same He will be, but that is not the vision of Jesus Christ for us. He didn't die to take us to a Judge, He died to redeem us to a Father!

Isaiah 1:19 If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land:

Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

a. Father I accept Your Fatherhood over me and all mine in Jesus Name. Amen

Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

b. Father let my whole life be expression of your grace and mercy.

c. Father, I am available for Your use, let my life show forth Your love and truth that others may see your love in me and through me, especially my children and family members.

Matthew 12:50 For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.

John 10:30 I and my Father are one.

Whatever God is to Jesus Christ, the same He is to us. If He hears Jesus, He will hear us when we pray too

d. Father makes us to be one with You and Your Son Jesus Christ in Jesus Name. Amen

e. As You and Your Son is one, Father help us replicate this true love in all our families in Jesus Name.

John 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.

John 16:26-27 At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you: For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me...

John 11:41-42 "...Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me. And I knew that thou hearest me always:"

f. Talk to Your Abba, Father on as many pressing issues that bothers your mind, He will take care of them in Jesus Name. Amen

2. HALLOWED BE THY NAME

God's Name is our Family Name. We must worship Him by our absolute reverence of His Name. A child that has no respect for his family name is only a bastard that is waiting to be exposed in the course of time. If we respect God's Name, which is our eternal family name, our children too in return will do everything they can to preserve and maintain our good name on earth.

1 John 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.

Matthew 11:25 At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.

a. Abba, Father hallowed be thy Name.

b. Father, I worship You and I bless Your Name. Worthy are you Oh Lord in Jesus Name. Amen

c. Thank You Lord for making me a part of Your Family.

Luke 22:29 And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me;

d. I am a part of the Kingdom, my part will not be missing in Jesus Name. Amen

May God bless you and keep you, may it be said of you that you called Him Abba, Father in truth and in spirit. And may your words command heavens attention and may angels come to your help each and every time you call Him Abba, Father, in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen and Amen!
