#### **ABBA, FATHER MAKES THE DIFFERENCE**

#### Breaking of Bread: Malachi 3:13-18

God is always the difference. He always make a difference once He is involved in a matter. The difference between a fatherless child and the one with a father is just the presence of a father. Every other lapses that may be seen in either of them can be traceable to absent or presence of a father in them both. This principle is true in our relationship with God. Once God is involved the difference will be clear. #### 1. Start within you.

Once you have been able to subdue the mind, silence self, God automatically resume ownership of your life and take care of all of your battles.

You do not actually believe until your confession and trust translate to peace within. Having peace within is evidence of answers to prayers. This is always the missing link. There can be no trust and faith, until we chose to let go. Let the past be in the past, ignore the presence where it is not helping and in faith look ahead to a good future.

Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Malachi 3:13 Your words have been stout against me, saith the LORD. Yet ye say, What have we spoken so much against thee?

Malachi 3:14 Ye have said, It is vain to serve God: and what profit is it that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts?

Malachi 3:15 And now we call the proud happy; yea, they that work wickedness are set up; yea, they that tempt God are even delivered.

a. I believe, yes Lord I believe, yes Lord I believe. It is well with me!

b. Father help my unbelief in Jesus Name. Amen

c. Father forgive me where I have wrongly accused you in my thoughts and in my behaviors and in all my wrong doing in Jesus Name. Amen!

d. I speak peace into my heart, irrespective of what I'm passing through, I have peace in Jesus Name. Amen!

### 2. Remind Him of His Covenant and Promises.

I love testimonies, they remind us of God's faithfulness and presence in our midst. There are no small testimonies. We should never underestimate the power of testimony, nor look down on any. However, some testimonies are self-announcing and one must never be found guilty of hoarding testimonies.

Lately, I was meditating and asking God, where are the testimonies? Yes, I'm aware some are work-in-progress and waiting for God to finished work on them but as a leader I want more and can't stop asking for more until every home and family is saturated with the power of God.

God was quick to answer my question, He says: *Remind me of my covenants and promises, even when I'm taking you through seemingly different and unfamiliar paths*. That all His works are meant to work out His covenants and promises for all who believes. He will yet surprise us still and He's still the Miracle Worker, the Promise Keeper and Righteous King. None of these has changed.

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Malachi 3:16 Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

Malachi 3:17 And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

a. Father remember your covenants and promises concerning me and have mercy upon me and my family in Jesus Name. Amen

b. Remind God of specific promises and covenants He has given youyou're your children.

(If you are not sure of this find out through studying the Word).

d. Father, remember my children and do them good in Jesus Name. Amen

e. I evoke the Covenant of Salt to bear fruit that are true in my children and in all that concern them in Jesus Name. Amen

#### 3. Power makes the difference.

The Presence of Abba, Father is not just in words but in demonstration of the power of God. Where the Word of God is there is power. Once God is involved, power must change hands.

Malachi 3:18 Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.

Psalms 66:7 He ruleth by his power for ever; his eyes behold the nations: let not the rebellious exalt themselves. Selah.

Ecclesiastes 8:4 Where the word of a king is, there is power: and who may say unto him, What doest thou?

a. Ask God to demonstrate His power in you and through you.

b. Ask God to make known the Excellency of His power in each of your children in Jesus. Amen

1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

1 Corinthians 2:5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

c. I'm a carrier of Divine grace through power in Jesus Name. Amen. Same for my children in Jesus Name.

#### 4. Sin can actually be a barrier.

Sin can wreck precious relationship between God and man and between man to another man and with Himself.

Isaiah 50:2 Wherefore, when I came, was there no man? when I called, was there none to answer? Is my hand shortened at all, that it cannot redeem? or have I no power to deliver? behold, at my rebuke I dry up the

sea, I make the rivers a wilderness: their fish stinketh, because there is no water, and dieth for thirst.

# Isaiah 59:1 Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:

a. Take conscious effort to repair broken bridges that may be hindering your ability to receive from God.

b. Ask for grace and mercies to overcome daily.

#### 5. Invest into God.

2 Chronicles 35:8 And his princes gave willingly unto the people, to the priests, and to the Levites: Hilkiah and Zechariah and Jehiel, rulers of the house of God, gave unto the priests for the passover offerings two thousand and six hundred small cattle, and three hundred oxen.

Ask for what you can do or contribute. Invest time and resources into spiritual things and leaders. Invest into people and families. God will give you answers to more requests when He sees you have helps others better from the previous ones He graciously granted. Every of our experiences are meant to prepare us for greater service.
