## HUMILITY: THE HIGHEST OFFICE OF THE LAMB OF GOD

#### Breaking of Bread: Revelation 5:1-14; Philippians 2:3-15

Love is the foundation of humility. A dry and arrogant heart cannot love and it takes humility to love. Humility is the key to all spiritual blessings. A spiritually endowed Christian (in faith, revelation, visions in dreams, words and spiritual gifts) with no humility will surely make a shipwreck of faith. When you see a Christian, tongue speaking, irrespective of titles, that is not humble, run as fast as your legs can carry you. Pride is infectious when allow to breed around one's. Humility is the highest attainment in spiritual growth. That was the office that gave the Lamb of God the NAME above all names and the title LION OF THE TRIBE OF JUDAH. Humility is strength.

#### 1. Humility in fellowship and friendship

Do not make friend nor go into business partnership with a proud person. The proud is only conscious of himself and care less about others.

Philippians 2:3 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.

a. Pray God lead your children to the fellowship of humble people.

b. Pray God to take away the proud from your children in all their ways.

## 2. Humility in marriage

Love, humility and friendship are the hallmarks of marriage. A marriage without humility is a marriage of inconvenience. Many dysfunctional marriages are as a result of selfish marital decisions rooted in pride and selfishness.

1 Samuel 18:3 Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul.

1 Samuel 18:4 And Jonathan stripped himself of the robe that was upon him, and gave it to David, and his garments, even to his sword, and to his bow, and to his girdle.

Philippians 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

Philippians 2:6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

Philippians 2:7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

a. Father I humbly surrender to Your will in my marriage in Jesus Name.

b. I pray for all my unmarried children, they will not be victims of proud spouses in Jesus Name.

c. Father, help me to be patience and humble in all marital decisions in Jesus Name. Amen

## 3. Humility in parenting

The proud will make a mess of parenting. It takes humility to accept that you are wrong before the children and apologize. The proud will not consider the children in many marital decisions. The proud will care less how his/her marital decisions will affect the children. It takes humility to love the children more than your immediate need and pleasure. Whatever you know the children will not be happy knowing you are doing, do not do it, no matter how beneficial they appear to be at the moment.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Colossians 3:21 Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged.

a. Father, baptize me with the spirit of humility to train and to raise my children in manner acceptable to You in Jesus Name. Amen

b. I will not allow pride and anger to mess up my parenting efforts in Jesus Name. Amen

#### 4. Humility in walking with God

A proud person cannot walk with God. God hates the proud. God will not defend the proud. The proud cannot be the reflection of the Lion of the Tribe of Judah. Another lion cannot walk side by side with the Lion of the Tribe of Judah, only sheep in whose heart is the Spirit of the Lamb of God can walk with Him. What an irony. The way of God is foolishness to man.

Philippians 2:8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Philippians 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

Philippians 2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

Philippians 2:11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Psalms 138:6 Though the LORD be high, yet hath he respect unto the lowly: but the proud he knoweth afar off.

Proverbs 15:25 The LORD will destroy the house of the proud: but he will establish the border of the widow.

Proverbs 16:5 Every one that is proud in heart is an abomination to the LORD: though hand join in hand, he shall not be unpunished.

a. I say no to a proud heart. I will not be taken over by pride in Jesus Name. Amen

b. I will not mess up my walk with God with pride and discontentment in Jesus Name. Amen

## 5. Humility in personal disposition

The proud is hated by all - hated by colleagues, by in-laws, by friends, by relatives and family members. Take care of your thoughts, we are nothing without God. Let others see Jesus (the Lamb of God) in you. The proud, who is too conscious of his/herself cannot keep any healthy relationship for a long time.

Philippian2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

Philippians 2:13 For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

Deuteronomy 33:24 And of Asher he said, Let Asher be blessed with children; let him be acceptable to his brethren, and let him dip his foot in oil.

### 6. Humility in doing assignments

Whatever you find yourself doing, do it heartily as unto the Lord. Serve God with your work, parenting, marriage etc. Be grateful for what you have. You can't say you love God when you don't love people. Take joy in service. No weapon that's fashion against me shall prosper but if one fail to do his work that can give the enemy room to work.

Philippians 2:14 Do all things without murmurings and disputings:

Psalms 106:25 But murmured in their tents, and hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD.

# 1 Corinthians 10:10 Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer.

a. I will serve with joy and gladness in Jesus Name.

#### 7. Abba, Father defends the humble

Philippians 2:15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

James 4:6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

1 Peter 5:5 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

a. I say no to arrogant heart and a proud look in Jesus Name. Amen

b. Pride will not rob me and my children the protective grace of the Lion of the Tribe of Judah in Jesus Name. Amen

#### 8. Humility is strength

To the proud and unbelieving humility is weakness, but to those who believe, it is strength.

Isaiah 30:15 For thus saith the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not.

Isaiah 32:17 And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever.

a. I will not lose spiritual strength and grace to pride in Jesus Name.

b. I will be strong in faith and humility in Jesus Name. Amen

#### 9. Only the humble can access the altar of prayer

No one can truly have fellowship with the Father and still stay proud, arrogant and unforgiving. Humility is key to spiritual strength. The proud cannot submit to God and cannot resist the enemy.

Matthew 7:7 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

Matthew 7:8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

a. I am bless with wisdom and utterance in the place of prayers in Jesus Name. Amen

b. I will not offer the sacrifice of a fool in Jesus Name.

c. As I intercede for my children and family, I will do it in the spirit of humility and grace in Jesus Name. Amen.

May God make you a true reflection of His glory and may He by you reveal Himself to many in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen
