All lessons and prayers are from the text used in today's Breaking of Bread.

- 1. In any way I have gone ahead of You, Father forgive me in Jesus Christ Name. Amen (see also John 10:5, 27).
- 2. In any way my lifestyle is affecting my family spiritual welfare, Father forgive me.
- 3. In any way I have been responsible for the physical breakdown of my family, Father, forgive me.
- 4. In any way sin has been responsible for my personal and family loss, Father forgive me n Jesus Name. Amen (see also Joshua 7:1-5).
- 5. In any way I have taken things for granted, and the results has been the reason for my defeat or family defeat, Father please forgive me in Jesus Christ Name. Amen (see also 2 Samuel 6:6-7).
- 6. In any way I have been glorying in the past, and keep losing focus on the future, Father forgive me in Jesus Christ Name. Amen (see also Philippians 3:13-16).
- 7. Father, please never allow the enemy to recover from the fear of you in me in Jesus name. Amen (see also Joshua 6:1)
- 8. Father let it be to the enemy of my soul according to their own words in Jesus name. Amen (see also Judges 7:13-14; Acts 23:21-24).

- 9. Father, act as of old on my matter again, keep no silence and don't stop in Jesus name. Amen
- 10. Father, no more loss of precious ground, reverse all loses and uphold the victory in Jesus name.
- 11. Father, this is not my Ebenezer, I'm unstoppable. This is a new start for me in Jesus name. Amen!
