COVENANTS WITH BETTER PROMISES

Breaking of Bread: Genesis 17:1-8

THEME SONG: Covenant keeping God, there is no one like You. I am that I am (Jehovah) there is no one like You.

WHY GOD GAVE PROMISES?

1. For Comfort and Assurance: "When I remember His promises I shout alleluia." God promises are God's assurances of comfort and peace for those who believe.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

- a. I have the promise of comfort and of peace in Jesus Name. Amen
- b. The promise of comfort and peace are mine (and for my children) by right of covenant in Jesus Name. Amen

c. I will not be dismay nor worry, I have no reason to be downcasted in Jesus Name. Amen

Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

d. I'm never forgotten nor forsaking in Jesus Name, for it is written, "I will never leave thee, not forsake thee"

God promises can also be a great source of fear and trembling for the wicked as well.

Psalms 9:17 The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God.

e. Father, keep your love in my heart, and in the hearts of my children. My generations shall not forget God in Jesus Name. Amen

2. To Access and Explore Him. God promises gives us the opportunity to discover God and know Him.

Proverbs 8:17 I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.

Proverbs 8:35 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD.

a. Father help me to find you early and to know you in the days of my strength in Jesus Name. Amen

b. Father help my generations to know you.

Romans 1:28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

- 1 Corinthians 1:31 That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.
- c. My generations will not be afflicted with reprobate minds in Jesus. Amen.
- **3. As Gains of Obedience and Service.** God will owe no one. He will reward our obedience and sacrifices for Him.
- 1 Corinthians 1:9 God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:24 Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.
- a. Father, thank You for the call and the Covenant of Grace upon my life and upon my generations forever.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil.
- 2 Timothy 2:11 It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him:
- b. Father, establish us in your covenant and keep us from evil in Jesus Name. Amen
- 2 Timothy 2:13 If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

- c. I believe and I trust the covenant and the promises and He Who gave them in Jesus Name. Amen
- 4. To Make A Difference Between Those Who Serves Him and Those Who Serve Him Not.

Exodus 11:6-7 And there shall be a great cry throughout all the land of Egypt, such as there was none like it, nor shall be like it any more. But against any of the children of Israel shall not a dog move his tongue, against man or beast: that ye may know how that the LORD doth put a difference between the Egyptians and Israel.

a. Father, put the mark of your covenant and favour upon us in Jesus Name. Amen

b. Father, let the covenant of Grace makes the difference in us and in all ours in Jesus Name. Amen

5. **Because He is God, His strength is without limit.** God is a spiritual force. His power is all compassing. His promises are complete and sure. Answers to prayers may tarry but it's not because God is weak or unable to do them. The only impossible situation is a situation not reported to God in prayers. Once reported, hold on to Him, He will do it.

Matthew 19:26 But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.

Mark 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

a. I lay all bare at your feet Lord. Do what only You can do in me and with me in Jesus Name. Amen

6. To Express His Mind and What He Will Do. God promises are His mind. They explain His mind and covenants to us in ways we can identify with them and keep them.

Jeremiah 23:3-4 And I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase. And I will set up shepherds

over them which shall feed them: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD.

Isaiah 43:19 Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.

Revelation 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.

a. Father show me a personal understandings of your mind for me and help me walk in them in Jesus Name. Amen

b. Father, help my generations to rest in you and in your covenant securely in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen

May God everlasting covenant of mercy, grace, love and truth be true in you and in your family for all generations in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen
